



UNM CAMP Scholarship Application

CAMP is a freshman scholarship program established to provide students with academic, social and financial support to enable them to complete their first year of college. CAMP provides many benefits, which include; supplemental financial aid assistance, one-on-one academic advisement, tutoring and mentoring, workshops focused on improving and developing students' skills, and social and cultural events.

An individual is eligible to participate in CAMP if he or she:

1. Has, or has at least one immediate family member who has, spent a minimum of 75 days during the past 24 months as a migrant or seasonal farmworker
Or
Is eligible to participate, or has participated, in the Migrant Education Program **Or**, in the National Farmworker Jobs Program.
2. Is enrolled or admitted for enrollment as a full-time student at UNM.
3. Is not beyond the first academic year of a program of study at UNM.
4. Is determined by CAMP to need the academic and supporting services and financial assistance provided by the program in order to complete an academic program of study at UNM.
5. Is a U.S Citizen or Permanent Resident

Program Requirements

Participants must agree to attend:

- 1 hour per week tutoring or mentoring
- 4 hours per week of study time
- Bi-weekly advising meeting
- Workshops
- Social and cultural enrichment activities

Participant Benefits

- Supplemental Financial Assistance (\$4,600/year)
- One-on-One Academic Advisement
- Personal Tutoring
- STEM, Study Skills and Development Workshops
- Cultural Enrichment Activities
- Freshman Success Class
